interruption and displacement of your family after a major event is often so much worse.

Since about 1960, Volusia County has experienced approximately nine hurricanes, but none have ever made direct landfall. We have also experienced tropical storms, major tornadoes, damaging windstorms and rain storms that have produced severe regional flooding. Hurricane Harvey not only was a direct hit with damaging storm surge, but it also brought several feet of rainfall. Although our topography is different, if we ever had the same scenario we would experience not only damaging wind but major flooding well beyond our coast.

A FEW QUICK PREPARATION TIPS

Our motto is "prepare for the worse and hope for the best"; therefore, HIG Insurance provides our customers with an extensive Family Hurricane Preparedness Plan to prepare them for the worse case scenario. It's impossible to provide you with a comprehensive plan here, but I will provide some useful planning ideas to get you started.

- 1. Have your insurance policies and all other important documents ready, should you have to leave your home voluntarily or by order.
- 2. Take pictures and video of the interior of your home including personal property and furnishings plus the exterior. If you have receipts for large items take them with you. It will make adjusting your claim so much easier for you and the adjuster.
- 3. Remove and secure all exterior property, pool items, chairs, trash containers, dumpsters, umbrellas and any item other items.

- 8. Prepare your home with plywood and hurricane shutters, and put towels in the tracks of your sliding glass doors to prevent water intrusion.

- I. Plan well ahead where you plan to seek shelter locally or out of State. If you plan to go to a local shelter take a small cot.
- 2. Know the evacuation routes to determine what your best
- 3. Stay Tuned: Keep the radio or TV tuned to emergency frequencies, the local news, or the weather channel for regular
- 4. Keep in touch with all family members and have a plan between each of you.
- 5. How do you plan to take care of your pets?
- 6. Keep in mind, your cell phone carrier may not work but have your phone charged and a backup battery just in case.
- 7. Take plenty of clothing, medication and other survival items,

such as flashlights, depending on where you plan to stay.

8. Take food and plenty of water.

Make sure your shrubs are trimmed in front of your cameras so that you get a clear video of people on your property. Watch your neighborhood for strangers wandering about.

You should know all of your neighbors on the street you live on as well as the ones behind you. The more people know about the neighborhood the better it is for everybody. 





Meet Opera Singer Carmel

The first profession I can remember aspiring to be a part of was an astronaut. There was nothing more captivating than the Space Shuttle missions—at least until I discovered video games. My next fleeting dream was to become a video game designer, oblivious to the fact that designing them was nothing like playing them. Later came the desire to become a baseball player, accountant, chef, etc. My indecisiveness led to a high school diploma sans plans for adulthood-ergo a career in the military as an aircraft mechanic. Fifteen years later, I am on a journey to becoming a college professor of the humanities, far from any other field I'd ever considered, yet I can't imagine ever doing anything else. This journey has brought about a deep-seated appreciation for the arts and the human experience.

So when Carmel Vaden, a soprano coloratura opera singer, said she knew she was going to be a singer/actress since early childhood, I could only think of just how seldom childhood fantasies become reality. A self-described introvert, Carmel was not as outgoing as some of the dynamic personalities who pervade show business.

"I always found a very quiet corner and became very, very quiet—literally praying because I was so nervous," said Carmel. "But when I got on stage, it was like I released my nerves to God."

Carmel's journey began when her parents took her to see *The Sound of Music* as a child. She has performed in recitals, plays, musicals, weddings, funerals, and concerts ever since. Originally from a small town in Canada with no traffic lights, Carmel's Acadian upbringing inspired much of her interest in the French-classic

genre—let alone classical music altogether. While her husband, Dave, was stationed at Fort Benning, GA, they heard an ad on the radio calling for auditions for The Sound of Music on the way home from church. The musical was to be performed at the Springer Opera House, Georgia's premier historical theater.

"I had to audition for it," Carmel said. "I didn't care if they asked me to sweep the floors or work in the green room—I had to be a part of it. So I auditioned, and the director, Roberta Illg, cast me as Maria!"

Carmel had never acted before. She wasn't familiar with terms like down-stage, left-stage, right stage,





and she had never sung with an orchestra. The board was furious with Roberta for casting Carmel over their ringer (their go-to who typically lands all of the lead roles). Roberta didn't choose their ringer because her voice was too mature for the role of Maria; Carmel's voice projected youthful innocence and naiveté, which was an essential ingredient in the casting of Maria.

Carmel recalled a moment when someone once remarked, "I think I just heard the voice of an angel" and another when a World War II veteran claimed he would carry the American flag, march, and follow her wherever she sings. Humble and grateful, she views her talent as a "gift that's been lent to her." There is a reason Carmel was booked a year in advance to sing at weddings as a teenager. Her voice has a quality that seems to transcend time and space. I say this because she was kind enough to perform during the interview:

Clearly exhibiting both hesitance and passion, Carmel taps a key on her piano, mentally calibrating her vocal intention with the musical note. She then performs a verse of "O Mio Babbino Caro" ("Oh My Beloved Father"), from the opera *Gianni Schicchi*, about a woman begging her father to allow her to wed the man she loves, threatening to throw herself over a bridge if he doesn't. Her beautiful voice reverberated off the walls and tile floors of her living room as if there had been a microphone and

amplifier. She followed with a verse from "Ave Maria," exuding equal parts humility and grace. Paralyzed as she concluded, I can only remember thinking how silence had never seemed so loud.

Although it is clear Carmel is gifted, she has spent most of her life honing her craft. She began piano lessons at a convent at the age of six, as the piano is an integral part of learning and applying musical theory as a singer.

"Ten years later, I would go to the convent to take piano and voice lessons after school," Carmel said, "then I'd get on the bus back home and start my school studies at 10 o'clock at night. That's how devoted and dedicated I was."

Sister Martine LeBlanc, Carmel's voice teacher since the age of 15, was getting all of the sopranos ready for a specific solo in Fauré's *Requiem Mass* during her first year of college. The "hauntingly beautiful" solo, Pie Jesu, which, according to Fauré, is "dominated from beginning to end by a very human feeling of faith in eternal rest," was to be auditioned for, the soloist voted by the choir.

"I was just a freshman among juniors and seniors with much more experience," said Carmel. "So you can imagine how nervous I was. After the vote, the director said to everyone, 'I appreciate your voting, but I've made my decision; I'm selecting Carmel.' He chose me for the same reason Roberta chose me—I had a lighter lyrical voice. After the concert, my dad told me he wanted me to sing Pie Jesu at his funeral. He passed away in 1998. It was one of the most difficult days, but I honored his wish."

Carmel has led a colorful, storied life of the arts. She has performed at the Bruton Parish Church in Colonial Williamsburg, VA, where every night chandeliers are lowered, lit, and people gather from off the street to listen to the night's performance. She was also asked to be on the board of the Smith Mountain Lake Good Neighbors, a non-profit that helps kids who lack adequate sustenance but instead decided to sing at events to raise awareness for the organization's cause. But one of her most notable performances was yet to come:

"One of our friends, Lieutenant Colonel Ernie Jackson, invited us to the Pentagon," Carmel's husband, Dave, said. "He was the principal of an elementary school, and he set up a direct feed from the Pentagon to Afghanistan. His elementary kids and Carmel sang for the troops in Afghanistan via the internet."

I remember the Star Spangled Banner would play on the base loudspeaker every day at 5:00 p.m. sharp. Whether driving, walking, or standing, if outdoors, we all had to stop while the anthem played. The same occurred as Carmel sang in the Pentagon; aids and officials alike halted immediately throughout as her elegant voice penetrated the halls of the Pentagon. Her vibrato rippling across the Atlantic both literally and figuratively, the impact of her performance was felt half way around the world.

What it must feel like to penetrate the souls of so many over a lifetime of performances. Although, like anyone else, Carmel has had opportunities seized and passed upon, but no one can deny that she has touched the hearts of many with eloquence and elegance through the sound of music.



Precision Carpet,

TILE AND UPHOLSTERY

Most Americans have lived in carpeted homes for most of their lives. Although hardwood, tile, and laminate flooring have become immensely popular over the years, carpet still seems to remain as the standard. Having lived several years abroad, I've become used to living without carpet, so moving back to the US has meant reacquainting myself with it, among many other adjustments. Unfortunately, many people, myself included, tend to neglect their carpeting, making it an afterthought compared to the rest of the responsibilities of maintaining their homes.

Steve Gois, co-owner and operator of Precision Carpet, Tile & Upholstery Cleaning, has not only highlighted the importance of proper carpet maintenance, but he has also changed my perception of carpeting, its care, and whether it is an asset or liability to my home. Precision Carpet, Tile & Upholstery Cleaning is a family owned business that started with Steve, his father, and his wife. He and his father, having been in the janitorial service industry for years up north, decided to take over a friend's janitorial service in Florida. After establishing a number of commercial clientele, a flourishing janitorial business was formed.

Eventually, clients began to request carpet cleaning services. Rather than limiting the company to janitorial services, Steve decided to attend carpet cleaning school and added certified carpet cleaning to the company's repertoire. Precision is now about 65 percent janitorial services and 35 percent carpet cleaning, employing 40 personnel. Additionally, it is also a full-service commodities dealer, supplying products (trash bags, paper towels, soap, soap dispensers, etc.) to the clients they serve.

Carpet serves as much more to a home than a source of comfort and aesthetics: it absorbs sound, provides itive or negative in Florida), but, most importantly, it serves as the home's most critical filter.

"People seldom realize the largest filter in the home is the carpet," Steve said. "It's filtering everything; all of the dust in the air is being filtered through the carpet. A common misconception is that people think they should remove the carpet if they have allergies. That's incorrect; if you look at light beaming through your window, you'll see many dust particles floating through the air. The dust has to settle somewhere, so if you have hardwood or laminate flooring, that dust just moves all over the place carpeting collects the dust and filters it. The key is to clean and maintain it once a year, at least."

Steve emphasized that families with pets and/or heavily trafficked areas in the home should get their carpets cleaned every six months. Those with no or low maintenance pets and less trafficked areas will most likely be fine with an annual cleaning. It is when people fail to clean and maintain their carpeting that it becomes an allergen farm.

But what about the period between cleanings? It would be nice if spilled wine, tracked mud, and pet accidents only happened just before a scheduled cleaning, but life isn't always so forgiving. One of the most common

see when servicing a home is that people often use poor or improper cleaning products when trying to spot-clean their carpets.

"People often buy one of those overthe-counter spot removers from the store, and they usually create more of a problem," Steve said. Such products typically just mask odors and leave a chemical residue in the carpet's pile. Just as with pool and automobile maintenance, the best decision is to use the same products as the professionals.

The vast majority of Precision's customer base are repeat customers—95 percent. This is primarily because customer satisfaction is paramount. Just as with any industry, there are legitimate, reputable companies and poor, fraudulent ones. It is important for consumers to discern between the two. According to Steve, there are a number of disreputable and/or fly-bynight operations in the carpet cleaning industry that over-soak carpets, use improper chemicals, and apply too much pressure and detergent, resulting in bacteria buildup, residue, and compressed dirt and allergens.

"Some companies will advertise \$10 per room, but when they get to the house, they will charge another \$15 per room for water and yet another \$10 per room for detergent," said Steve. "When they leave, they've actually charged \$80 per room, and a \$29job just became a \$300-400job."

"For the last few years, we've been dealing with this company out of Jacksonville, called Precision Carpet Care," said Steve. "We're Precision Carpet, Tile, & Upholstery Cleaning. They've been around for a couple of years, as a bait-and-switch operation. They go in and advertise five dollars per room—I can't even pull my hoses out of my \$100,000 machine for five dollars! Then, they go into the house, because they prey on the elderly, and walk out with 500-700 bucks! And then they change their phone number, so when a customer tries to call them back to fix what they did, they can't get a hold of them. They then look up the company online, and what pops up is my company!"

One day, Steve logged on to Facebook, only to find that the mother of actor Cuba Gooding, Jr., who lives in Palm

Coast, had left a scathing review of his company. It turned out that she had contacted Precision Carpet Care in Jacksonville, mistaking them for Precision Carpet, Tile & Upholstery Cleaning, and they had totally ripped her off. Steve replied to her message and explained what happened. Fortunately, she apologized and deleted

"No legitimate carpet cleaning service can go in and service your entire home for \$30," Steve said, "not if they're using the proper equipment, chemicals, and techniques. A standard 2-3 bedroom home should cost around \$80-100."

Steve recalled another time, a couple of years ago, when he was out on a job in Port Orange. Another carpet cleaning company was servicing a home up the street at the same time. The lady from that home walked over

to the neighbor Steve was servicing and asked if she could take a look at how they were doing. What compelled her to come over was the fact that she could hear Precision's machinery from up the street and could barely hear the machinery from the company she hired. The other company had been using a portable unit out of a van with a small generator. Steve went out the following week to clean up their mess.

"Customers need to be wary," Steve said. "But there are other legitimate carpet cleaning companies besides us, and there's plenty of business for all of us."

I'm sure we can all agree that sometimes saving money initially can end up costing more in the long run. I often have to remind myself that we vote with our dollars; therefore, when it comes to the proper maintenance of your carpet and your home altogether, be sure to cast your "vote" for a reputable company that values its customers and their hard-earned money, like Precision Carpet, Tile & Upholstery Cleaning.



his October, instead of stressing with carved pumpkins and haunting the aisles of your local grocer trying to decide which candy will be the least tempting to polish off before Halloween, why not treat yourself to a spooky getaway? Visit the most notoriously haunting place of all -Transylvania, Romania. If thoughts of vampires, werewolves and dank crypts are not enough to persuade you to book a flight, then you should know that Romania's central region is also a place of breathtaking beauty, unspoiled nature and intriguing history - all well worth the trip.

The Transylvanian region is bordered by the Carpathian Mountains, which slope down to green lush forests, flower-dotted meadows and quaint hamlets. 


