





teacher for 30 years.


Activities/Hobbies: Roger is a car guy, likes gardening and storytelling (Marlene says "loquacious" is really an understatement and wishes they had written down all of his many "Rogerisms" over the years). He also volunteers at the SE Volusia Historical Society Museum. He has owned almost 200 cars in his lifetime and at times has bought and sold a car in the same day. He is a "fixer" of anything and everything. He loves to go to yard sales and bring home random "stuff" (because it is cool-looking or he might need it someday). Like the pretty shiny water pump for a GMC something-or-other that he thought would look great on the mantle (if they had a mantle). Marlene jokes that she is on a clean-out program but Roger is on a bring-it-home project. And he will spend hours on the computer at "YouTube University" learning how to fix something and ordering parts.

Marlene likes to sing (check out "Marlene and the Mayhems" at the clubhouse karaoke event one night), read, color and listen to music. And they enjoy going to the community theatres in NSB and Deland.

Music: Roger is on the listening side of music. Although he says that he is a hummer. However, music holds special memories for Marlene. She remembers piano recitals, marching band, dance band, church choir and musical productions-especially Oklahoma.

What college/university did you attend? Roger entered the Air Force right out of high school, and Marlene earned her BA and MA at Western Michigan University.





#### Where are you originally from?

Marlene lived in Michigan her whole life prior to here, and Roger is from South Dakota. They lived in Grand Ledge, MI, for 26 years before mov-

How long have you lived in this neighborhood? Almost nine years.

How are you involved in the community? Marlene sings in the church choir at Sacred Heart and enjoys the neighborhood card groups, mahjong and anything social. She also enjoys karaoke at the VB Clubhouse.

Roger likes "beautification" projects. Back in Lansing, he had 10 acres of woods where he liked to work/play. He always wanted to turn it into a park, but that never quite came about. Here in the neighborhood, he has made the beautification of the pump station area across the street from their home his pet project.

Over the years they have volunteered for the American Red Cross (delivering blood), Meals on Wheels, and were Volunteer Coordinators and respite care providers for Hospice for many years. They really enjoyed their Hospice work and feel they got so much more out of it than they put in.

If you have kids, what activities are they involved with? Ours is a blended family. Our children live in Tennessee, Ohio, Michigan, and three here nearby in Florida. Between us, we have six grown children, seven grandchildren (six boys and one girl) and one great-grandson.

What is your favorite part about living in your neighborhood? The way folks pull together. After they had lived here about a year, Roger said, "You know, there are a lot of characters here." Marlene told him to go look in the mirror and he'd see another one.

Roger is originally from Sioux Falls,



South Dakota. But then he became the Happy Wanderer. He joined the Air Force after high school at the age of 18. He went to Air Traffic Control School at Keesler Air Force Base in Mississippi. He was then stationed on a beautiful resort island in the South Pacific called Okinawa. (Well, it wasn't quite a resort, but it did have pretty water.) After that, they sent him to a place that had a lot of sand but no water - Roswell, New Mexico - where the aliens live - but at that time there were no aliens there. (According to Roger, the aliens came later after they closed the base and they needed a tourist attraction.) He got out of the AF in 1959 and went home to Sioux Falls. There he was employed at that airport by the FAA as a trainee and youthful controller. Other places along the way included Ft. Wayne, IN, Honolulu, HI, Oklahoma City, OK, Akron, OH, Chicago, IL, Toledo, OH, Kalamazoo, MI, Minneapolis, MN, and finally Lansing, MI (because it was warmer than Minneapolis and Marlene was there). He worked as a Supervisor

from 1982 until his retirement in 1991. He learned to fly while he was an instructor in Oklahoma City. He sold his house and used the funds to obtain his pilot's license (much to his first wife's dismay). Back then he was able to fly on the GI Bill and it cost him \$1.30 an hour. He earned his commercial instrument rating. He still loves traveling the blue roads, the tiny blue or black roads on the map that are the ones less traveled.

Marlene lived in Michigan her whole life before moving here. She was a teacher for 30 years. She taught everything from Developmental Kindergarten through eighth grade, has a Masters in Reading, and taught reading skills in the learning labs at the community colleges.

"The lure of spending time with our youngest preschool-age grandson is what brought us to Florida. We left our mittens in the mitten (Michigan's lower peninsula) and headed South in October of 2009. We had seen this neighborhood while going for a Sunday drive on one of our weekend visits with our son. Our house was a model - there were only about 13 homes in Promenade Parke when we first saw it. Roger and I had seldom agreed on various homes we'd looked at but when we walked into 3385 Tesoro, we loved the house and the view. Looking out over the pool, the pond, and vacant land beyond was

very inviting. Across the street, we had wide open spaces almost like Little House on the Prairie. We bought it at 5 o'clock that night and then leased it back to Paytas for two years. When we moved in, we almost felt a little lonely, but my goodness what a difference a few years have made.

When we moved in, I made up a flyer to introduce ourselves and offer a chance to get to know neighbors. What a great beginning. Early on, Linda Zwolinski and I tried to greet new neighbors with muffins, etc., but it soon became too daunting of a task. Ha! Today we would need an entire crew and a bakery! We started having a happy hour once a month and a dine out. After our neighborhood exploded it was difficult to find spots that could accommodate us. But great folks offered other opportunities. Mike and Judy Bridges and Phil and Chris Hall set up corn hole tournaments. Phil also had several regattas with remote-controlled boats. Others reached out to find opportunities for Promenade Parke like the outing to Sinatra's in Cassadaga, The Escape Room, Stonewoods, bus trips organized by Gary & Carol Tobiasz, card groups, pickleball, Mahjong, bowling, etc. And Lee De-Lieto has magnificently orchestrated several holiday dinner galas.

We just grew so quickly. Now it takes a village, and this "village" hasn't taken a back seat. With our growth, the potential for new ideas and opportunities are waiting to be introduced to the wonderful residents of Promenade Parke."

## Then Mom Said, Not Really!"

I am a second-generation Italian and proud of it. At my concerts, I have spoken publicly for years of my Italian background, and specifically my Sicilian heritage with great pride. It has been said, by my wife, friends, and those who have worked with me over the years, that I exemplify most every possible Italian characteristic. You know, the important ones that can be considered germane to Italian personalities, specifically those of Sicilian traits.

I am very emotional, sensitive, complex, demonstrative, affectionate, caring, very hot-tempered, expressive, very excessive, creative, artistic, imaginative, open, enjoy cooking, difficult at times, have high artistic expectations of those I work with and most Italian of all ... I loved and adored my mother and father.

I boldly and shamelessly say "I am an Italian" or at least ... for many years I have called myself one. Then I had this conversation with my dear mother over breakfast a couple of years before she died at age 97. That conversation went like this.

"Mom, I don't remember dad's mother. What was her name?" Mom said: "You know I can't remember. Your dad's parents were divorced and I only saw her a couple of times before she died. I really didn't know her well, but I did know she was French."

I said, "What do you mean she was French?"

Then Mom said: "She was born in France and as a teenager, her family moved and settled in Palermo, Sicily, and that is where she met your father's father - your grandfather. I do remember, just like your dad, she had beautiful blue eyes."

I then said, "Really! So, I am three-quarters Italian and one-quarter French because of dad's mother." Then mom said: "Not really!" So, I said, "What do you mean?"

Then Mom said, "Your father's father was a Turk! Your father's father was orphaned when he was born in Istanbul. He moved to Palermo, Sicily, with relatives where he was adopted by a family named Martorano. He met your father's mother in Palermo, and they married and moved to Rochester, New York, where your dad was born. They ultimately divorced which was unheard of at that time."

I said, "OK. Then I am one-quarter French on my father's mother's side and one-quarter Turk on my father's father's side. OK.

OK! That still leaves me one-half Italian."

Then Mom said, "Not really! My mother was born in Tunisia. In her teens, her family relocated to San Giuseppe, Sicily, right outside of Palermo. She met my father there and they married."

"Oh!" I said. "Then I am one-quarter French on my father's, mother's side, one-quarter Turk on my father's, father's side, one-quarter Tunisian on my mother's mother's side ... and I am still one-quarter Italian."

Then mom said, "No-not really! My father was Greek. My maiden name is Sgro. Sgro is an 8th-century Greek family name! My dad's family relocated to Sicily from Athens, Greece, when he was a teenager. They lived in San Giuseppe, Sicily, where he met

"OK," I said. "Let me see if I understand this. I am one-quarter French on my father's mother's side - one-quarter Turk on my father's father's side - one-quarter Tunisian on my mother's, mother's side and one-quarter Greek on my mother's father's side. Is that correct?" And my mom said, "Yes!"

I then said, "I'm not Italian!"

"No-not really", she replied. "It was not necessary to talk to you about your European heritage because you are an American. We are respectful of our Italian culture but we are American. That's why we never encouraged you to learn to speak Italian." My mother was a very wise and wonderful woman, who died at age 97. She and my dad filled my life with much love. What more could I have asked for as a young, multi-heritage European man?

I am proud of my European background, but not as proud as I am of my being an American. I'm a second-generation Italian-American and I am blessed that my mother and father raised me with a European culture of regard, respect, responsibility, family, accountability, and a love of life. God bless you, Mom.
